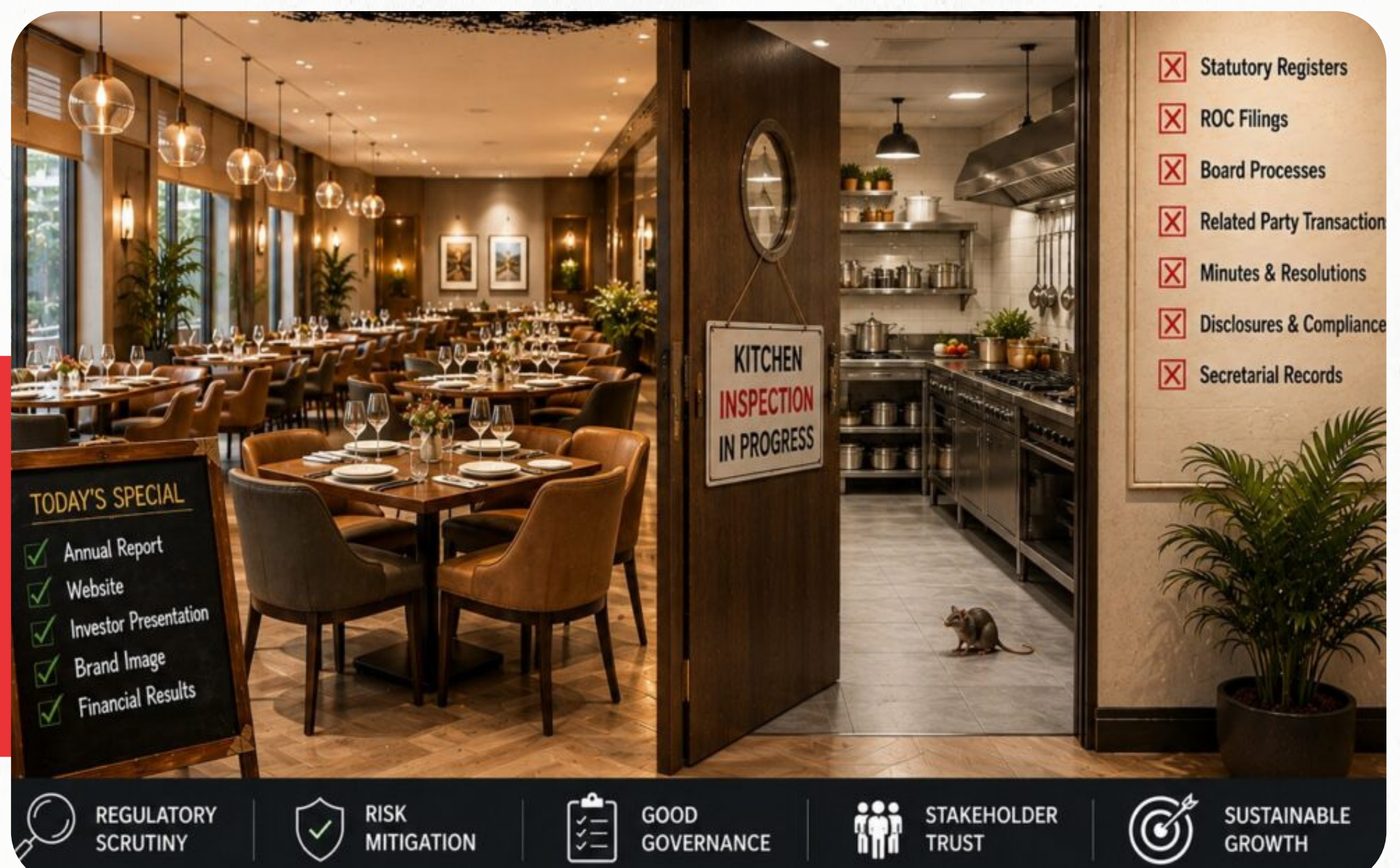

Converting a Privately Placed InvIT into a Publicly offered InvIT: **Is Trust Deed Ready?**



This article highlights that while SEBI's August 8, 2025 circular streamlined the regulatory process for converting privately placed InvITs to publicly offered ones (removing minimum sponsor contribution lock-ins), it left the trust deed (charter document) unaddressed. To avoid ultra vires actions or regulatory friction, trusts must proactively amend restrictive clauses—such as advertising bans, exclusive placement memorandum mandates, transfer restrictions, and annual (versus required half-yearly) valuation/distribution schedules—prior to filing the draft offer document.
